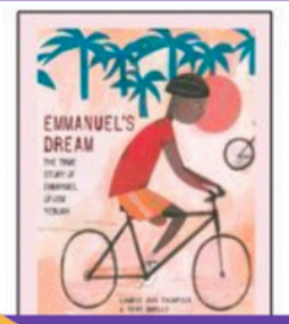

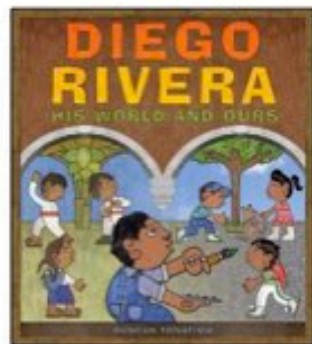

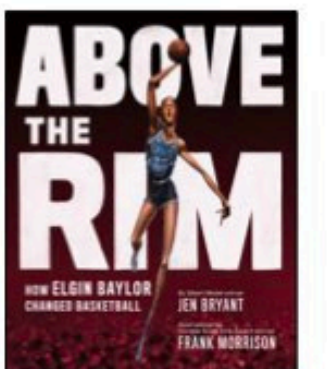

Women's History Biography Lesson Plans

First Lesson:

(You can teach this lesson in person or virtually. All you need is the book to read and a way for students to respond to your questions.)

- 1) Introduce your students to Women's History Month. Explain that March is Women's History Month in America. We want to honor the women who have contributed to our world. They have made the world a better place for all of us.
- 2) Explain that today, they will learn about a woman in history and at the end of the book, you will ask them how this person made the world a better place.
- 3) Read a picture book biography aloud. You can choose from the list starting on page 24.
- 4) At the end of the book, ask your students: How did this person make America a better place? What made her want to do this? Who or what was an influence in her life?

Lesson Extensions:

- Can you find a short YouTube video related to this person, to bring her to life for your students?
- Find the country where this person came from on Google Earth.
- Students can write a thank you note to this person, thanking them for their contributions. If the person is still living, you may be able to send the messages via email and get a response.
- Your students can make a collage on a Google Slide of images related to this person's life and accomplishments.
